




Demographics Belmont - YRBS 2021











ELECTRONIC VAPOR USE by grade















Ranking of Stressors:

Middle School (N=643)

- School demands/expectation (assignments, homework, etc.) 33%
- Busy schedule (school, activities, sports, etc.) 22%
- Family demands/expectations (academics, grades, etc.) 15%
- Worrying about the future (college, career, etc.) 12%
- Other family/personal issues 8%

COVID-19 PANDEMIC EFFECTS

Q: During the pandemic, have you experienced any of the following?


Middle School (N=643)

- Feelings of fear, anger, sadness, worry, numbness, or frustration 55%
- 2 Changes in appetite, energy, desires, and interests 40%
- Difficulty concentrating and making decisions 38%
- Difficulty sleeping or nightmares 30%
- I have not experienced any of these things 29%







High School: Lifetime substance use among students who experience overwhelming stress:



Of those HS students who experience overwhelming stress...


- 20% Vape
- 53% consume alcohol
- 21% use marijuana

Those who don't experience overwhelming stress are less likely to use substances.


- Experience overwhelming stress (N=300-320)
- Not experience overwhelming stress (N=700-720)

Percentage of students who experience depression




High School: Students who experience depression compared to hours of sleep:



Students who consider suicide among those who experience electronic bullying:


Percentage of students who consider suicide
